Having trouble with your residence in a motel? You may be covered by landlord-tenant law, depending on a few things. Before you look at the other information on this site, ask the three following questions:

- 1) Have you lived there for less than 30 days?
- 2) Is rent charged daily?
- 3) Is there maid or linen service every day or every other day?

If you answered yes to *all* of these questions, you are **not** covered by landlord tenant law. An attorney can give you more information about your rights.

If you said no to *any* of these questions, you should be covered by landlord tenant law. See the specific information about your concern on our website.
